Remarks	<ul style="list-style-type: none">➤ BSA will provide training to participants one week before the camp starts.➤ A grant of USD150 to the cost of visa expenses and a special scholarship of USD600 assisting with the traveling cost will be provided to participants upon arrival for employment at camp.➤ BSA will provide room, board, health and medical insurance coverage to participants while in camp.➤ Participants will receive wages equal to what is paid to American counselors at the camp during the service period (USD150-175 per week). To entitle the said payment, participants must serve the entire period shown on the application.➤ After completing the programme, a 30-day grace period will be granted for traveling in the U.S.➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical & traveling insurance (outside the camp period), airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference and any extra charges for offsite activities where special equipment or additional transport is required.➤ For more information, please visit http://www.scouting.org/international .
