## **Wearing of Queen's Golden Jubilee Medals and Fund Raising Breast Pins on Scout Uniform**

Some leaders were spotted wearing the Queen's Golden Jubilee Medal and/or certain Foreign Organization's Breast Pins on Scout Uniform recently.

The Queen's Golden Jubilee Medals were awarded to personnel of Regular, Reserve and Cadet forces of the United Kingdom who were in effective service on 6 February 2002 and had completed 5 full years of service.

Some Commonwealth Governments (such as Canada) also issued the same Queen's Golden Jubilee Medals to various personnel and organizations. The service personnel requirement was the same as the UK Government.

For those who have been awarded with the Queen's Golden Jubilee Medal please submit the relevant Gazette Notice, qualification for the award and particulars of conferment to the Chief Commissioner for endorsement and entering into their personal record, otherwise they would not be permitted to wear them on Scout Uniform.

As to the Breast Pin given out by The Office of Basic Education Admission of the Bureau of General Administration of the Ministry of Education of a certain Government for their contribution in the fund raising for the building of a school; it is not permitted to be worn on Scout Uniform.
