2. Eligibility: Leaders who hold:
 - (a) a valid Warrant; priorities will be given to Scout Leaders, Assistant Scout Leaders, District Scout Leaders and Assistant District Commissioners(Scout); and
 - (b) the following Certificates:
 - i. Scout Fundamentals Training Course; or
 - ii. Scout Fundamentals and Leadership Training Course; or
 - iii. Scout Basic Course.

3. Course Fee: HK\$ 350 per person, including the cost of handouts, meals, refreshment and camp fee (transportation will not be included). Course fee should be made payable by crossed cheque to the “Scout Association of Hong Kong”.

4. Application: Please complete Form PT/02e which can be downloaded at <http://www.scout.org.hk/en/download/training/> and return by mail or in person together with a crossed cheque, and copies of Warrant and Certificates to Training Branch, Room 908, 9/F, Hong Kong Scout Centre, Scout Path, Austin Road, Kowloon on or before the deadline. (Incomplete form or copies of the prescribed Certificates may affect the application result.)

5. Deadline: 22 May 2009 (Friday)

6. Others:
- (a) Late applications or late payments of course fee will not be considered.
 - (b) Applicants will be notified in writing of the application result.
 - (c) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
 - (d) The dress code for the course will be Scout Uniform No. 3 or any other dress to be decided by the Course Leader.
 - (e) Participants should prepare the Scout Outdoor Activity Dress during the course.
 - (f) Participants should be familiar with the Scoutcraft skills mentioned in the “Scout Basic Skills Resource Package” so as to apply them in the training course.
 - (g) Since June and July is the rainy season, participants should be aware that the date of camping may be postponed to 18 - 19 July 2009 (Saturday & Sunday) under inclement weather conditions.
 - (h) The medium of instruction is Chinese. However, assistance will be provided to English-speaking participants.
