<b>Venue</b>	Mt. Makiling, Los Banos, Laguna, PHILIPPINES (Venue of the 10 <sup>th</sup> World Jamboree)
<b>Eligibility</b>	Contingent Members : Scout Members aged 12 – 17 Leaders of Contingent : Scout Leaders aged 18 or above International Service Team : Scout Members and Leaders aged 18 or above
<b>Camp Fee</b>	USD200
<b>Air Ticket*</b>	Around HKD3,500 (Round Trip Economy Class)
