<b>Remarks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Age of participants is calculated on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Jamboree.</li><li>➤ Participants are expected to arrive on 24 July 2009 and depart on 28 July 2009.</li><li>➤ The fee covers food rations, tentage, activities, souvenirs, home hospitality, insurance, and inland transportation between airport and the campsite.</li><li>➤ Various activities include Scout Skills, High Adventure Program, Pioneering, Survival Activity, and water sports.</li><li>➤ Home Hospitality can be arranged after the Jamborette for up to 3 days upon request.</li><li>➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical and traveling insurance, airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference and any extra charges for offsite activities where special equipment or additional transport is required.</li></ul>
