



11th Practical Adult First Aid Certificate Course

The captioned course will be held by Training Branch of Scout Association of Hong Kong in collaboration with the Accident & Emergency Training Centre of Hospital Authority in September 2009. The course aims to enhance first aid knowledge and provide practical training to participants. Content includes “Basic Methods to Maintain Life”, “Procedures of Handling Emergency Accidents”, “Handling Methods of Common Accidents in Scout Activities”, “Treatments of Bleeding & Fracture”, “CPR for Child & Adult”. This is an elementary course and is suitable for both beginners and those who want to refresh their knowledge.

This course is one of the selective skill courses recognized by the Non-Sectional Leader Wood Badge Training Scheme. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who have completed all sessions of the course on time and passed the examination. Mr TANG Nim-chi, Trainer will be the Course Leader. Details are stated below:

2. Eligibility: Leaders who:
 - (a) hold a valid Warrant, Instructor Appointment or Certificate of Appointment; and
 - (b) have completed the General Information Course.
3. Course Fee: HK\$ 195 per person, including the cost of bandage and meals (refreshment will not be included). Course fee should be made by crossed cheque. Each applicant must issue a separate cheque payable to “Scout Association of Hong Kong”.
4. Application: Please complete Form PT/02e which can be downloaded at (<http://www.scout.org.hk/en/download/training/>) and return by mail or in person together with the crossed cheque, and copies of Warrant and Certificates to Training Branch, Room 908, 9/F, Hong Kong Scout Centre, Scout Path, Austin Road, Kowloon on or before the deadline. (Incomplete form or copies of the prescribed Certificates may affect the application result.)
5. Deadline: 14 August 2009 (Friday)
6. Others:
 - (a) Applicants will be notified in writing of the application result.
 - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
 - (c) During the course, participants should be dressed in Scout Uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.
