<b>Venue</b>	Kandersteg International Scout Centre, South of Bern, SWITZERLAND
<b>Service Period</b>	Winter 2010 ➤ 13 December 2009 —13 March 2010 Spring 2010 ➤ 14 March — 11 June 2010 Summer 2010 ➤ 12 June 2010 — 11 September 2010 Autumn 2010 ➤ 12 September — 11 December 2010
<b>Eligibility</b>	➤ Scout Members or leaders aged 18 or above ➤ Able to communicate in English ➤ Available for the whole service period
<b>Registration Fee</b>	Free of Charge
<b>Air Ticket*</b>	Around HKD8,000 (Round Trip Economy Class)
<b>Job Nature</b>	Job duties include running indoor and outdoor activities, working in shop, serving meals, doing laundry, cleaning room, etc.
<b>Remarks</b>	➤ The Centre is built in a village in the heart of the Swiss Alps. Participants should be able to work for 3 months at a height of 1,200M and above. ➤ Participants must arrive on the 1 <sup>st</sup> day of service period, and take part in the FULL staff training before serving in the Centre. ➤ Accommodation, meals, daily utilities, full accident insurance coverage, and basic equipment for hiking, climbing and skiing will be offered. ➤ Participants will receive 1 day-off and 1 Staff Night Out per week, as well as 1 Staff Day Out at the end of the season paid by the Centre. ➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical and traveling insurance, airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference and any extra charges for offsite activities where special equipment or additional transport is required. ➤ For more information, please visit the KISC website <a href="http://www.kisc.ch/">http://www.kisc.ch/</a>
