Admission Permits will be issued to participating Groups/Units on a first-come-first-served basis. The Permits will be ready for distribution by Monday, 19 October 2009. Groups/Units must bring along their Permits and present them when entering the Hong Kong Stadium. All Groups & Units must be seated at the assigned section of the Stadium as indicated on the Permits.

Admission tickets for Youth Award Recipients and their relatives will be issued separately by Programme Branch.

Invitation Card

Invitations are extended to Lay Members of Scout Groups and Sponsoring Authorities. Scout Groups may request for Invitation Cards from the respective Regional HQs or International & Liaison Branch (for SJD Groups) commencing Monday, 19 October 2009. Invited guests will be admitted to the Scout Rally upon the presentation of the Invitation Cards. Please note that the Invitation Cards are not applicable to Scout members and their relatives. Please state the number of Invitation Cards required in the Registration Form.

Programme

Apart from the parade and the Scout Band performance, interactive activities and other performances matching the theme of the Scout Rally will be organized. Details will be announced in due course.

Transportation

Parking facilities are not available in the vicinity of the Hong Kong Stadium. Groups/Units and individuals are advised to attend the Scout Rally by public transport. The suggested arrival routes are set out below:

Only vehicles with Entry Permits can access the area of Hong Kong Stadium on Sunday, 8 November 2009. Groups/Units arriving by coaches are requested to apply for Coach Permits by duly completing and returning the Registration Form. Priority will be given to Groups/Units from remote districts or with special needs. Coaches with the Permits are requested to adhere to the following arrangement:

1. 1-way / 2-way Coach Permit
The Permit must be displayed on the windscreen of the coach.
2. Arrival / Departure Schedule and Alighting / Pick-up point
Coach should arrive at / depart from the area of Hong Kong Stadium for alighting / picking-up passengers according to the allocated time schedule. In order to avoid traffic congestion, coaches must follow the instruction directed by the duty officer in charge of traffic arrangements.

Coach Permits will be issued to Groups/Units by Monday, 19 October 2009 together with the Admission Permits. Details of the time and location for alighting and picking-up passengers will be marked on the Permits. Applicants who have not received any notification by Monday, 19 October 2009 should contact the Administration Branch at 2957 6304.

Attire

1. Youth members : Scout Uniform.
2. Leaders : Scout Uniform No.3 (Beret, Shirt, Scarf, Trousers/Skirt) or Scout Uniform No.11 (Beret, Shirt, Tunic, Trousers/Skirt, Tie) with Medal.
3. Administrators : Lounge Suit or Scout Uniform No.3 (Beret, Shirt, Scarf, Trousers/Skirt) or Scout Uniform No.11 (Beret, Shirt, Tunic, Trousers/Skirt, Tie) with Medal.
4. Invited guests : Lounge Suit or Uniform with Medal.
5. Parents and friends: Smart Casual.
