The Association has always been taking a very strict approach to the awards granted. Since the awards are granted at the absolute discretion of the Association Headquarters, it is not necessary to mention the kind of award to be recommended in the nomination form.

Notes on Decorations and Awards
(for Awards in 2010)

I. Awards for Merit

Awards of the Gold Dragon, Silver Dragon, Bronze Dragon, Gold Lion, Silver Lion, Bronze Lion, Distinguished Service Cross, Distinguished Service Medal, Distinguished Service Award and Good Service Award are granted at the absolute discretion of the Association Headquarters.

Nomination form (DA1) should be completed and signed by the District Commissioner as nominator and endorsed by the International Commissioner. *When filling in the nomination form, it is not necessary to mention the kind of award to be recommended.* A Group Scout Leader wishing to initiate any such nomination should contact the District Commissioner in the first instance.

Nominations for an award for the first time and for those who have been awarded Good Service Award for higher awards must reach the Chief Scout Executive according to the following schedule:

Group/District	31 October 2009	30 November 2009

Nominations for those who have been awarded Distinguished Service Award and/or above for higher awards must reach the Chief Scout Executive according to the following schedule:

<i>Unit to initiate nomination</i>	<i>Deadline to reach International Commissioner</i>	<i>Deadline to reach Chief Scout Executive</i>
Group/District	15 May 2010	31 May 2010

II. Certificate of Appreciation

Nominations for the Certificate of Appreciation to Scouter's spouse/parents should be submitted by the District Commissioner, using the nomination form (DA2) for one or more nominations. The District Commissioner would send the form to the Scout Executive (International & Liaison) for the approval of the International Commissioner.

A Group Scout Leader wishing to initiate any such nomination should contact the District Commissioner in the first instance.

Nominations for Certificate of Appreciation (for Awards in 2010) must reach the Chief Scout Executive according to the following schedule:
