<b>Remarks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ Age of participants is calculated on 17 July 2010.</li><li>➤ Our Association is invited to bring 2 patrols, each consisting of 1 leader and 6 scouts to attend the Jamborette.</li><li>➤ Participants are expected to arrive on 20 July 2010 and depart on 30 July 2010.</li><li>➤ The fee covers food, activities, camp badge, neckerchief, inland transportation between Edinburgh or Glasgow and Campsite, overnight stays at Scout halls for early arrival and late departure, and home hospitality.</li><li>➤ Home Hospitality for up to 5 days in the homes of Scottish Scouts can be arranged after the Jamborette.</li><li>➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical &amp; traveling insurance, airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference and any extra charges for offsite activities where special equipment or additional transport is required.</li><li>➤ For more information, please visit <a href="http://www.jamborette.org.uk/">http://www.jamborette.org.uk/</a> .</li></ul>
