- evaluate the Sectional Training Schemes and introduce them to the others;
- explain the history, development and effects of the concept of 'team';
- state the International Scout Movement in general;
- state skill on human relationship;
- introduce the youth service in general and demand for such service;
- state the practical leadership skill;
- state the insurance policy and measures of handling accidents;
- devise the programme of Group Meetings and training activities in the long term;
- illustrate the roles of Commissioners, Group Scout Leaders and Administrators in Scout Movement;
- lead his/her Group members to complete the tasks under his/her supervision;
- state the safety guideline on outdoor activities and participate in one wild camp activity;
- understand the religious policy of the Association and participate in one Scout's Own;
- identify the supports and resources available in the Association and other organizations;
- conduct fund raising campaign for Scout Movement;
- expand Group business;
- identify his/her own further training; and
- deal with administration records and files.

3. Course Fee: HK\$ 500 per person, including the cost of handouts, camp fee, refreshment and meals (dinner and breakfast at Gilwell Campsite will not be included). Course fee should be made by crossed cheque. Each applicant must issue a separate cheque payable to “Scout Association of Hong Kong”.
