



1045th General Information Course

The captioned course will be held by Training Branch in March 2010 and Mr. WONG Lup-tack, Trainer will be the Course Leader. The course aims to introduce the fundamental principles, history and organization of Scouting Movement. Content includes “Knowing Scouting”, “Fundamental Principles of Scouting”, “Scouting Movement and Training”, “Scouting Discipline and Etiquette”, “Functions and Qualities of Group Leaders”, “Functions of Scout Groups”, “Support from Districts, Regions and Association Headquarters”. After completing the course, candidates can be able to:

- state the aims and methods of Scout Association of Hong Kong;
- state how the five scout sections make use of progressive training programmes in accordance with the aims of the association;
- state how the training sections can be effectively linked up;
- list the personal traits, qualities and skills that an adult leader should be possessed of;
- state the roles of adult leaders in the Scouting Movement;
- state the support that can be provided by staff of the Scout districts and regions; and
- state the whole Wood Badge Training Scheme.

2. Eligibility:
 - (a) Leaders who hold a valid Warrant or Instructor Appointment; or
 - (b) Leaders who hold a valid Certificate of Appointment; or
 - (c) Rover Scouts who proceed to the assessment for Baden-Powell Award;
or
 - (d) Venture Scouts who proceed to the assessment for Dragon Scout Award; or
 - (e) Anyone who are interested in Scouting and aged over 18.
3. Course Fee: HK\$ 250 per person, including the cost of Scout Basic Skills Resource Package, handouts, catering, camp fee and refreshment, etc. Course fee should be made by crossed cheque. Each applicant must issue a separate cheque payable to “Scout Association of Hong Kong”.

 - (a) Applicants will be notified in writing of the application result.
 - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
 - (c) During the course, participants should be dressed in Scout Uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.
