- state the aims and objectives of the Scout Promise and Law and explain the Vision, Mission & Values of the Association and how they can be made understandable and acceptable to members;
- state the roles of Group Leaders;
- state the procedures of a Scout's Own;
- demonstrate different types of Group Meetings; and
- identify unit members' further development needs.

 - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
