



Hong Kong Scout Rally 2010 (IV)

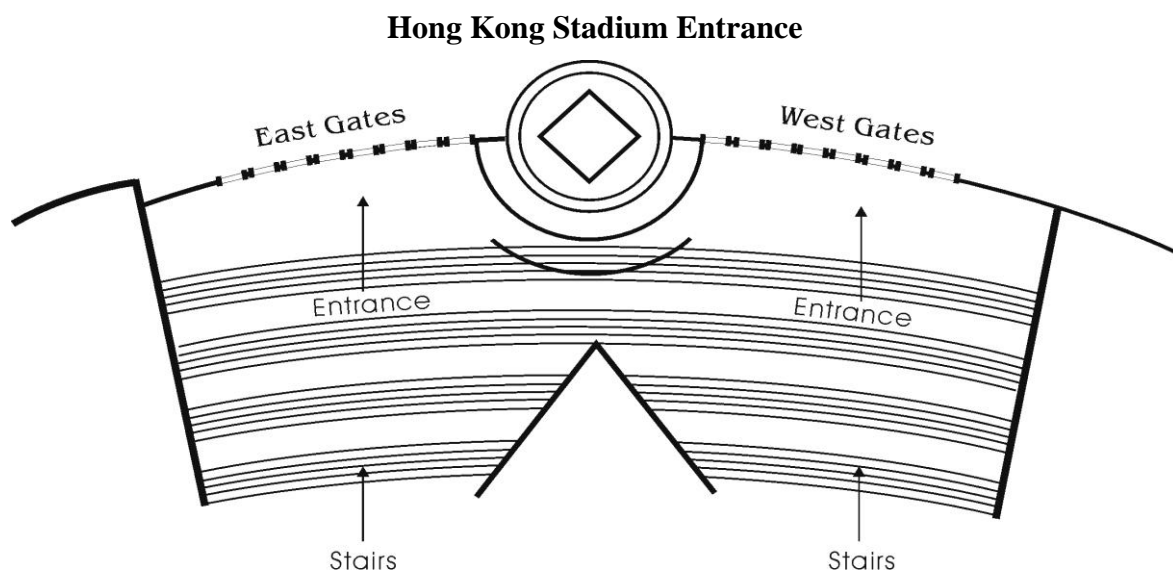
The Hong Kong Scout Rally 2010 will be held on Sunday, 21 November, 2010 at the Hong Kong Stadium at 10am. Details are as follows:

Admission Time

The Stadium will be opened for entry at 8:30am. All participants should be seated before 9:45am.

Admission Tickets

Admission Tickets will be ready for distribution to participating Groups/Units in late October. All Groups/Units must present the Admission Tickets when entering the Hong Kong Stadium, and be seated at the assigned section of the Stadium as indicated on the Admission Tickets. For admission, all Scout Youth Members and their relatives should be accompanied by Leaders.



Admission Tickets for Youth Award Recipients and their relatives (maximum 2 persons per recipient) will be issued separately by the Programme Branch.

Invitation Card

Invitations are extended to Lay Members of Scout Groups and Sponsors. Scout Groups may collect Invitation Cards from the respective Regional HQs or (for SJD Groups) the International & Liaison Branch from Monday, 1 November, 2010. Invited guests will be admitted to the Scout Rally upon the presentation of the Invitation Cards.

Transportation

1. Road Arrangement

- (1) From 8:00am to 10:00am, a one-way bilinear traffic flow on Eastern Hospital Road and Caroline Hill Road will be adopted. All vehicles at Leighton Road will be diverted to Hysan Avenue and Hoi Ping Road, then Caroline Hill Road to Hong Kong Stadium.
- (2) Right after the conclusion of the Scout Rally (around 12:30pm), part of Caroline Hill Road will be closed as needed. Drivers must follow instructions issued by the Police.

2. Coach

- (1) The deadline for applying for Coach Permits has expired. Groups/Units which have not applied for Coach Permits are advised NOT to arrange coaches for transporting their members.
- (2) Coach Permits will be issued to Groups/Units in late October together with the Admission Tickets. Details of the time and location for alighting and picking-up passengers will be marked on the Permits.

3. Taxi and Private Cars

- (1) Taxis and private cars will be allowed to drop off and pick up passengers at the front gateway of the Hong Kong Stadium. However, no waiting will be permitted.

4. Bus

- (1) Based on estimated crowd flow after the Scout Rally, Citybus will decide on the frequency of service of the special Route No.117R.
- (2) Single fare for this route: Adult (\$13.4); Children under 12 (\$6.7)
- (3) Bus stops of this route: Hong Kong Stadium (Cotton Path)→Cross Harbour Tunnel→Hong Kong Science Museum→Centenary Garden (Mody Road)→New World Centre→Kowloon Hotel→Haiphong Road→Kimberley Road→Shamrock Hotel→Kowloon Central Post Office→Pitt Street→Grand Tower (Shantung Street)→Bute Street

5. Car Park

- (1) The Car Park of the Hong Kong Stadium will only be accessible to vehicles with special Parking Permits, and will not be open to the public. The Parking Permits must be displayed prominently on the windscreen of the vehicles.
- (2) Limited paid parking spaces are available at the carpark of the South China Athletic Association near the Hong Kong Stadium.

Raising the National Flag

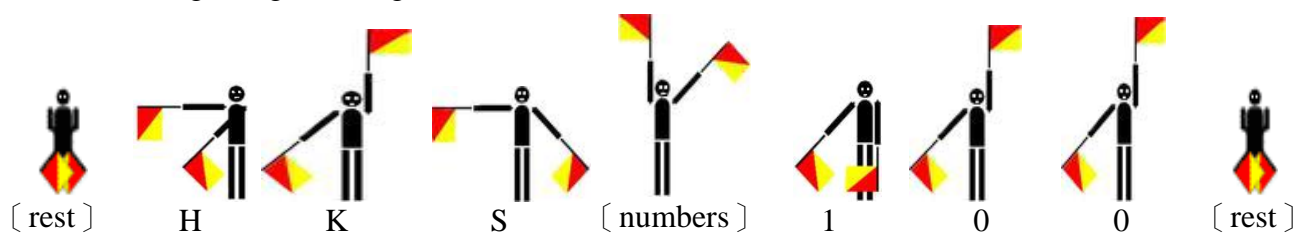
As in past years, the National Flag will be hoisted and the National Anthem will be played during the Scout Rally. In the process, all participants should remain standing and silent, and all Leaders should make the Scout salute.

Programme

Besides the march past and band performance, this rally will feature a centennial flag signaling activity and a parade of participating Groups/Units.

Centennial Flag Signaling Activity: To celebrate the upcoming centenary of Hong Kong Scouting, all participants will join a centennial flag signaling activity. To mark our team work and our centenary, we intend to apply to the Guinness World Record for recognition of this activity as a world record. Details are as follows:

1. Each participant will get 2 specially-designed fans cum signal flags at the entrance. Each Group/Unit should assign only one Leader to collect the specially-designed fans cum signal flags with the Admission Ticket at the designated collection point. For details, please refer to the attached “Collection Points for Fan-Signal Flags” (Appendix).
2. To reduce carbon footprints, all participants are urged to bring these fan-signal flags home to be re-used in flag signaling exercises or as paper fans. **Please do not discard these items on the seats or in the rubbish bin.**
3. At the time of the activity, all participants will stand up and follow the instructions from the MC and make the flag signals for “HKS100” (as shown below, representing the Centenary of Hong Kong Scouting).



4. To ensure the activity proceed smoothly, please encourage all Scouts to practice beforehand.

Distribution of Souvenir Badges

A yellow-coloured souvenir badge commemorating the participation in the flag signaling exercise will be distributed to each participant at the close of the Rally's programme upon his/her departure from the Stadium. Distribution time and location will be announced during the Rally.

Dress Code

1. Youth members: Scout Uniform.
2. Leaders: Scout Uniform No.3 (Beret, Shirt, Scarf, Trousers/Skirt) or Scout Uniform No.11 (Beret, Shirt, Tunic, Trousers/Skirt, Tie) with Medal(s).
3. Administrators: Lounge Suit or Scout Uniform No.3 (Beret, Shirt, Scarf, Trousers/Skirt) or Scout Uniform No.11 (Beret, Shirt, Tunic, Trousers/Skirt, Tie) with Medal.
4. Invited guests: Lounge Suit or Uniform with Medal(s).
5. Parents and friends: Smart Casual.

Others

1. For safety reasons and to be considerate towards others, please avoid gathering at the staircase of the Hong Kong Stadium and on the road outside.
2. When the ceremonies are in progress, all participants should remain in their respective seats or locations.
