## Hong Kong Scout Centenary Jamboree Mid Night Run

The association will organize the captioned activity during the Hong Kong Scout Centenary Jamboree. Two groups namely “Challenge” and “Experience”, are established to suit different campers with various experience and health condition. Details of the activity are as below:

### (A) Challenge Group

1.1	Date	30 December 2010 (Thursday) to 31 December 2010 (Friday)
1.2	Start point	Tung Chung, Lantau Island
1.3	Format	Complete a trail (around 11 km) on foot in a team of 4 members and 1 reserved member within 6 hours
1.4	Route	Tung Chung → Shek Mun Kap → Tei Tong Tsai → Ngong Ping → Ngong Ping 360 Rescue Trail → Tung Chung
1.5	Assembly Time	10:30pm, Thursday, 30 December 2010
1.6	Assembly Venue	To be announced later
1.7	Eligibility	All local sectional members and leaders participating Jamboree
1.8	No. of Places	5 teams for each Sub-Camp, 25 teams in total


### (B) Experience Group

2.1	Date	30 December 2010 (Thursday) to 31 December 2010 (Friday)
2.2	Start point	Ngong Pang, Lantau Island
2.3	Format	Complete a trail (around 6 km) on foot in a team of 4 members and 1 reserved member within 6 hours
2.4	Route	Ngong Ping → Ngong Ping 360 Rescue Trail → Tung Chung
2.5	Assembly Time	10:00pm, Thursday, 30 December 2010
2.6	Assembly Venue	To be announced later
2.7	Eligibility	All local sectional members and leaders participating Jamboree. Each team may comprise no more than 2 campers from oversea/mainland
2.8	No. of Places	5 teams for each Sub-Camp, 25 teams in total

(C) Application : Please return the completed application form to Programme Branch via the Sub-Camp Office (i.e. Regional Headquarters' Office) before the deadline. Completed Parent Consent forms (PT/46) 【 Available from Programme Branch or can be downloaded from the SAHK web page <http://www.scout.org.hk>】 should be submitted together for applicants who under the age of 18.

(D) Deadline : Wednesday, 1 December 2010

- (E) Dressing & Equipments : 1. Each participant should be in appropriate dressing for hiking activity and equipped with lighting tools, whistles, compass, food and drinking water.  
2. Each team should be equipped with  
a) at least 1 409 MHz transceiver ; and  
b) at least 2 mobile phones for communication in emergency.  
All devices must be fully charged before the activity.
- (F) Check Points : Check points will be set along the route. The location, opening and closing time of each check point will be announced later.
- (G) Awards : 1. A certificate of merit will be awarded to the champion, first runner-up and second runner-up (must complete in full team) of each group (Challenge and Experience).  
2. All teams completed the trail in full team will be awarded a team certificate.
- (H) Briefing : A briefing session will be held on Tuesday, 14 December 2010 at 7:30pm at room 1114, 11/F, Hong Kong Scout Centre. Each team should have at least one representative to attend.
- (I) Others : 1. All participants should be fit for hiking and possess basic knowledge of map reading, use of compass and first aid.  
2. Participants should arrange appropriate training before the Jamboree, e.g. training in physical fitness, team cooperation and trail familiarization. Reserved team member should also be arranged.  
3. The Challenge Group of this activity is under “Sub-Camp Competition” and each Sub-Camp can assign no more than 5 teams to join. The completion time for the first three teams (must complete in full team) of each Sub-Camp will be counted as the Sub-Camp result. The least total of the Sub-Camp will be the champion.
