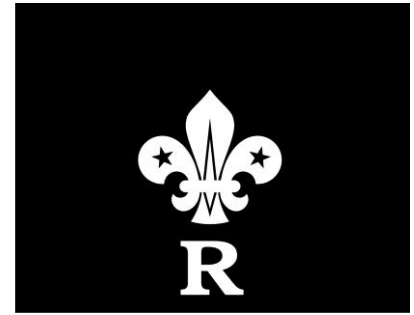
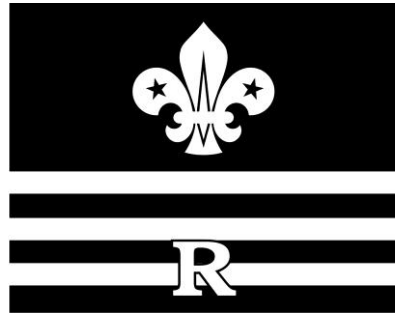


### **Retired Scouters / Commissioners Wearing Shoulder Badges**

Pursuant to the provisions of “Policy, Organisation & Rules” of Scout Association of Hong Kong, Scouters / Commissioners shall retire on reaching their sixty-fifth birthday. Taking into consideration that some of the retired Scouters and Commissioners wish to wear their Scout uniform with shoulder badges after their retirement, the Chief Commissioner’s Council has agreed that retired Scouters / Commissioners may wear their Scout uniform with shoulder badges of the highest rank in their Scouting service before their retirement. An “R” pin (“R” indicates “Retired”) should be placed at the bottom of the shoulder badge as shown in the examples below to indicate that they are retired. In case of older type of Scout uniform with rank insignia positioned on the breast of the shirt the “R” pin can also be placed on the rank insignia. However, the pin is not necessary on mess kit.

The “R” pin is now available for sale at the Scout Shop at HK\$10 each.
