



## 19<sup>th</sup> Human Relations Training Course

The captioned course will be held by Training Branch in October 2011 and this course is one of the major skill courses recognized by the Non-Sectional Leader Wood Badge Training Scheme. Mr Peter LEE Yiu-hung, Leader Trainer will be the Course Leader. After completing the course, candidates can be able to :

1. know the process of Human Relations development;
2. know the relationship between “self” and interpersonal interaction;
3. know and review the impact of irrational thoughts on interpersonal interaction;
4. know the theories and models of interpersonal interaction;
5. know the concept and attitudes of effective communication;
6. understand “self” in achieving effective communication;
7. know the interaction skills of interpersonal communication and distinguish the mode of one-way and two-way communication;
8. know the use of responding skill, emotional reflection and empathy in interpersonal communication;
9. know the skills in concrete questioning and responding in interpersonal communication;
10. acquire the self expression in interpersonal communication;
11. know the confrontation skills, and its handling techniques in interpersonal communication.

  - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
