The Jamboree-On-The-Air cum Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTA-JOTI) is an annual international event for World Scouting organized by the World Organization of the Scout Movement. It usually takes place on the 3rd Saturday and Sunday of October every year for promoting friendship among Scouts all over the world through radio and telecommunications. Millions of Scouts and Guides worldwide will make contact with each other over such weekend.

The theme this year is “Peace, Environment and Natural Disasters”. The idea is to take advantage of the wonderful impact, which the JOTA-JOTI has on its participants, to make them realize the importance of communication in times of crisis. In addition to the traditional JOTA-JOTI activities, this year’s JOTA-JOTI aims to enhance a free and direct exchange of ideas between Scouts of all nations, providing them an opportunity to taste and to understand other’s culture.

Scout members are welcome to join the following activities:

- Communicate with scout members worldwide by designated radio frequencies
- The JOTA-JOTI Fun Fair organized by the Association Headquarters (AHQ) or activities at the registered JOTA-JOTI substations organized by various Regions / Districts / Scout Groups
- Chatting at the Scoutlink IRC and Teamspeak
- Visit the JOTA-JOTI’s website and join our Facebook Group
- Participate in the Long Range Radio DX Night and JOTI Reunion at AHQ on Saturday night (15 October)

Scout members attending the recognized JOTA-JOTI activities organized by AHQ or registered substations could purchase the souvenir badge on site. In addition, a special souvenir will be offered to members who have participated in the JOTA-JOTI Fun Fair and activities held by the registered substations. Also, scout members with amateur radio license are welcome to request for our radio QSL cards.

 3. Silk-screen Printing
Participants may bring a cotton T-shirt or handkerchief to have the logo printed by silk-screen printing (towel will not be accepted).

Participants may take part in various Internet services including Internet Relay Chat (IRC) and Teamspeak Voice Chatting; and Web 2.0 services such as Plurk and Twitter.
 5. Scouts Online (Scout TV Online and Podcast)
Participants may record and make their messages publicized through Scout TV Online and Podcast activities.
 6. Badgers' Gallery
Participants may make friends with other scout members by leaving contact information during badge exchange.
