



Hong Kong Scout Rally 2011 (II)

The Hong Kong Scout Rally 2011 will be held on Sunday, 30 October 2011 at the Hong Kong Stadium at 10 am. All Scouts, leaders and members are urged to attend this annual event. Parents and friends are also welcomed.

Registration

Admission tickets will be issued to participating Groups/Units on a first-come-first-served basis. The Admission Tickets will be ready for distribution to the Groups/Units by Monday, 10 October 2011. All Groups/Units must present their Admission Tickets when entering the Hong Kong Stadium, and be seated at the assigned section of the Stadium as indicated on the Admission Tickets.

Admission tickets for Youth Award Recipients and their relatives will be issued separately by the Programme Branch.

Invitation Cards

Invitations are extended to Lay Members of Scout Groups and Sponsors. Scout Groups may obtain Invitation Cards from the respective Regional HQs or the International & Liaison Branch (for SJD Groups) commencing Monday, 10 October 2011. Invited guests will be admitted to the Scout Rally upon the presentation of the Invitation Cards. Please note that Invitation Cards should not be used for Scout members and their relatives. The number of Invitation Cards required, if any, may be stated in the Registration Form.

Programme

Besides the march past and band performance, all Groups/Units are cordially invited to participate in “Centennial Promise” (百年承諾), a human puzzle performance, showing our commitment to serve the community. In addition, there will be Lion and Dragon Dance Performance (龍騰獅躍賀百年).

1. Centennial Promise (百年承諾)

It is a human puzzle performance. Some Scouts will be arranged to sit on the Upper Level of the Hong Kong Stadium holding up a folder during the performance. As part of the puzzle, participants will contribute to the large picture showing a Chinese slogan “童軍同心 · 服務社群”, meaning the unity of Scouts to serve the community. At the same time, other participants will hold up folders in different colours representing the fruitful life in the Scout Movement.

2. Lion and Dragon Dance Performance (龍騰獅躍賀百年)

Leading by a fashion show of past Scout uniforms, 2 teams composed of 100 Scouts respectively will perform on lion dance and knotting by a giant dragon at the same time, to show the joyfulness and prosperity brought by the centenary of Hong Kong Scouting.

Transportation

Parking facilities are not available in the vicinity of the Hong Kong Stadium. Where possible, participants are advised to take public transport. Suggested arrival routes are set out below:


Only vehicles with Entry Permits can access the area near Hong Kong Stadium. Groups/Units planning to arrive by coaches are requested to apply for Coach Permits by completing and returning the Registration Form. Priority will be given to Groups/Units from remote areas or with special needs. Coaches with Permits are requested to adhere to the following arrangements:

- (1) **1-way / 2-way Coach Permit:** The Permit must be displayed on the windscreen of the coach.
- (2) **Arrival / Departure Schedule and Alighting / Pick-up point:** Coach should arrive at / depart from the area near Hong Kong Stadium for alighting / picking-up passengers according to the allocated time schedule and at the designated location. In order to avoid traffic congestion, coaches must follow the instructions of the duty officers in charge of traffic arrangements.

Coach Permits and details of the time and location for alighting and picking-up passengers will be ready for distribution to the Groups/Units by Monday, 10 October 2011. Groups/Units which have not been notified by this date should contact the Administration Branch at 2957 6304.
