<b>Eligibility</b>	Contingent Members : Scout Members aged 12 or above Leaders of Contingent : Scout Leaders aged 18 or above
<b>Camp Fee</b>	USD40 or NTD1,000
<b>Air Ticket*</b>	Around HKD2,000 ( <i>Round Trip Economy Class excluding Airport Tax &amp; relevant surcharges</i> )
<b>Remarks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ <b>Age of participants is calculated on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Jamboree.</b></li><li>➤ Participants are expected to arrive on 10 November 2011 and depart on 13 November 2011.</li><li>➤ The fee covers tentage, meals, activities, souvenirs and insurance within the Jamboree.</li><li>➤ Inland transportation between Kaohsiung International Airport or Taiwan Taoyuan International Airport and campsite is <b>NOT INCLUDED</b>.</li><li>➤ Home hospitality can be arranged before or after the Jamboree for up to 3 days subject to request and suitable arrangements are able to be made. Additional fee may apply.</li><li>➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical and travelling insurance, airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference, any additional transportation charges for offsite activities as well as any personal and contingent's expenses.</li></ul>
