3rd Seamanship Training Course

(The medium of instruction: Cantonese)

The captioned course will be held by Training Branch in January to February 2012 and Mr CHONG Pak-yin, Trainer will be the Course Leader. After completing the course, candidates can be able to:

1. state the aims and objectives of Seamanship;
2. understand the importance of equipment and safety knowledge in Seamanship;
3. state the basic technique of boating and understand the effects of weather, tides and currents in Seamanship;
4. know how to launch and lift a boat from pier and slipway; and
5. state the methods in handling emergencies in Seamanship.

2. Eligibility: Leaders who:
 - (a) hold a valid Warrant, Instructor Appointment or Certificate of Appointment; and
 - (b) have completed the General Information Course; and
 - (c) can swim 50 m in clothes, tread water for more than 2 minutes.
3. Course Fee: HK\$ 150 per person, including the cost of handouts and refreshment, etc. Course fee should be made by crossed cheque. Each applicant must issue a separate cheque payable to “Scout Association of Hong Kong”.
4. Application: Please complete Form PT/02e which can be downloaded at (<http://www.scout.org.hk/en/download/training/>) and return by mail or in person together with the crossed cheque, and copies of Warrant and Certificates to Training Branch, Room 908, 9/F, Hong Kong Scout Centre, Scout Path, Austin Road, Kowloon on or before the deadline. (Incomplete form or copies of the prescribed Certificates may affect the application result.)
5. Deadline: 14 December 2011 (Wednesday)

 - (a) Applicants will be informed in writing of the application result.
 - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
 - (c) During the course, accepted participants should be dressed in Scout Uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.
