The captioned course will be held by Training Branch from February to March 2012 and Mr LAU Yee-leung Joseph, Leader Trainer will be the Course Leader. After completing the course, candidates can be able to :

1. understand the religious policy of the Association and participate in one Scout's Own;
2. illustrate the roles of Commissioners, Group Scout Leaders and Administrators in Scout Movement;
3. state the safety guideline on outdoor activities and participate in one wild camp activity;
4. explain the history, development and effects of the concept of 'team';
5. introduce the youth service in general and demand for such service;
6. state the International Scout Movement in general;
7. state the insurance policy and measures of handling accidents;
8. devise the programme of Group Meetings and training activities in the long term;
9. evaluate the Sectional Training Schemes and introduce them to the others;
10. lead his/her Group members to complete the tasks under his/her supervision;
11. identify the supports and resources available in the Association and other organizations;
12. conduct fund raising campaign for Scout Movement;
13. deal with administration records and files;
14. expand Group business;
15. state skill on human relationship;
16. state the practical leadership skill.

 - ii. two Commissioner Skill Courses.
3. Course Fee: HK\$ 600 per person, including the cost of handouts, refreshment, camp fee and meals. Course fee should be made by crossed cheque. Each applicant must issue a separate cheque payable to "Scout Association of Hong Kong".

 - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
 - (c) During the course, participants should be dressed in Scout Uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.
