<b>Venue</b>	Dambulla, Matale District, Central Province, SRI LANKA
<b>Eligibility</b>	Contingent Members : Scout Members aged 12 – 17 Leaders of Contingent : Scout Leaders aged 18 or above International Service Team : Scout Members or Leaders aged 18 – 45

<b>Remarks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ <b>Age of participants is calculated on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Jamboree.</b></li><li>➤ Participants are expected to arrive on 31 March 2012 and depart on 7 April 2012, while IST members are expected to arrive on 30 March 2012 and depart on 8 April 2012.</li><li>➤ The fee covers meals, activities, souvenirs and inland transportation between Bandaranaike International Airport and the campsite.</li><li>➤ Home hospitality can be arranged after the Jamboree for 3 days subject to request and suitable arrangements are able to be made.</li><li>➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical and travelling insurance, airport departure tax, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference, any additional transportation charges for offsite activities and any personal and contingent's expenses.</li></ul>
