84th Scout Fundamentals Training Course

(Medium of instruction: Cantonese)

Training Branch is planning to organize the captioned course in March 2012. Mr AU YEUNG Chor-yuen, Assistant Leader Trainer will be the Course Leader. After completing the course, candidates should be able to:

1. state the characteristics and needs of group members and the training and activities that are available to cope with their individual needs;
2. explain how sectional characteristics and training methods can be applied to facilitate the development of individual members;
3. state the aims and contents of progressive badges and proficiency badges in the Sectional Training Scheme;
4. state the aims and objectives of the Scout Promise and Law and explain the Vision, Mission & Values of the Association and how they can be made understandable and acceptable to members;
5. state the roles of Troop Leaders;
6. state the procedures of a Scout's Own;
7. demonstrate different types of Group Meetings; and
8. identify unit members' further development needs.

 - (a) hold a valid Warrant of Scout Section; and
 - (b) have completed the General Information Course.
3. Course Fee: HK\$ 220 per person, which covers course materials, meals, refreshment and camp fees. Fees should be made payable by crossed cheque to the "Scout Association of Hong Kong".

Incomplete form or copies of the prescribed certificates may affect the application result.

 - (a) Applicants will be informed in writing of the application result.
 - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
 - (c) During the course, accepted participants should be dressed in Scout uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.
