### 1116<sup>th</sup> General Information Course

*(Medium of instruction: Cantonese)*

Training Branch is planning to organize the captioned course in March 2012. Mr CHAN Kwok-wai, Leader Trainer will be the Course Leader. The course aims to introduce the fundamental principles, history and organization of Scouting Movement. Content includes “Knowing Scouting”, “Fundamental Principles of Scouting”, “Scouting Movement and Training”, “Scouting Discipline and Etiquette”, “Functions and Qualities of Group Leaders”, “Functions of Scout Groups”, “Support from Districts, Regions and Association Headquarters”.

  - (a) hold a valid Warrant or Instructor Appointment for leaders; or
  - (b) Certificate of Appointment for administrators; or
  - (c) Rover Scouts who proceed to the assessment for Baden-Powell Award; or
  - (d) Venture Scouts who proceed to the assessment for Dragon Scout Award; or
  - (e) Anyone who are interested in Scouting and aged over 18.
3. Course Fee: HK\$ 180 per person, which covers the cost of Scout Basic Skills Resource Package, course materials, meals and refreshment. Fees should be made payable by crossed cheque to the “Scout Association of Hong Kong”.
4. Application: Please fill out the Application Form PT/02e, which can be downloaded at <http://www.scout.org.hk/en/download/training/> and send it by mail or by hand to the Training Branch, Room 908, 9/F, Hong Kong Scout Centre, Scout Path, Austin Road, Kowloon together with the course fees and copies of the above-mentioned warrant and certificate on or before deadline. Incomplete form or copies of the prescribed certificates may affect the application result.
5. Deadline: 24 February 2012 (Friday)

  - (a) Applicants will be notified in writing of the application result.
  - (b) Participants should attend all sessions of the course on time. Certificates will only be issued to candidates who complete all requirements of the course.
  - (c) During the course, accepted participants should be dressed in Scout uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.
