### 103<sup>rd</sup> Knotting Course

*(The medium of instruction: Cantonese)*

Training Branch is planning to organize the captioned course in March 2012. Mr MAK Sak-hong, Leader Trainer will be the Course Leader. After completing the course, candidates should be able to :

1. state the difference between rope work and knotting;
2. state the technique and application of knotting;
3. state the definition and terminology of knotting;
4. shows the classification of knots, and state its purpose;
5. demonstrate and teach all knots in course through knot board.
