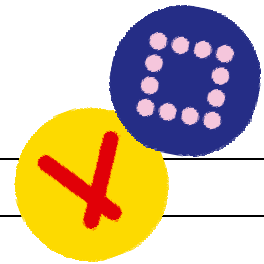


## Jamboree Denmark 2012



<b>Date</b>	21 – 29 July 2012
<b>Venue</b>	Holstebro, DENMARK
<b>Eligibility</b>	Contingent Members : Scout Members aged 12 – 25 Leaders of Contingent : Scout Leaders aged 21 or above International Service Team : Scout Members or Leaders aged 18 or above
<b>Camp Fee</b>	EUR240 (DKK1,775)
<b>Air Ticket*</b>	Around HKD9,000 ( <i>Round Trip Economy Class excluding Airport Tax &amp; relevant surcharges</i> )
<b>Remarks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>➤ <b>Age of participants is calculated on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Jamboree.</b></li><li>➤ Participants are expected to arrive on 21 July 2012 and depart on 29 July 2012. Dates of arrival and departure for IST members depend on the jobs allocated.</li><li>➤ The fee covers meals and activities.</li><li>➤ Inland transportation between Billund Airport and campsite is <b>NOT INCLUDED</b>.</li><li>➤ Home hospitality in various locations in DENMARK can be arranged from 18 to 21 July 2012 subject to request and suitable arrangements are able to be made.
