

# 「領導及管理文憑」課程 招生程序正式展開

**Diploma in Leadership and Management\***  
In collaboration with the Scout Association of Hong Kong (SAHK)

**Aims and Objectives**  
The programme aims to offer the participants' leadership skills so that they can meet new challenges at work and in other voluntary roles.

The core subject 'Leadership in Practice' (comprising of 3 units) is modelled on the World Rugby Training Scheme (WRITS) of the Scout Association of Hong Kong (SAHK). By engaging in its experiential learning approach, students will engage in a unique learning process that enables them to apply the knowledge and practice the skills they have acquired in a hands-on setting, and gain confidence to lead with impact.

\*These subject will be delivered by SAHK. It is equivalent to the World Rugby Training Scheme (WRITS) delivered by SAHK. Those who have completed the WRITS of SAHK may apply for credit transfer.

Students are allowed to exit the programme for the award of 'Certificate in Leadership and Management' on successful completion of 12 core subjects or at least one subject in the area of leadership and one subject in the area of management with an Award GPA of 2.0 or above.

**Programme Schedule**  
Students are normally expected to take about 18 to 22 months to complete the 30 credit core subject. Lectures/seminars/tutorials of this core subject are normally conducted during the first semester of study. Then, workshops and module training will take place over a period of 12 months.

Students are required to study the elective subjects, one at a time, in parallel with the core subject. Each elective subject will be completed in 1 year.

**Entry Requirements**

- 4 passes in the HKCEE (including English (Ykkabus II) and Chinese) and a minimum of 2 years of relevant working experience; OR
- 3 passes in the HKCEE (including English (Ykkabus II) and Chinese) and successful completion of Form 6 with a minimum of 1 year of relevant working experience; OR
- Successful completion of Professional Degree Programme offered by a recognized tertiary institution and a minimum of 1 year of relevant working experience; OR
- Holder of Associate Degree / Higher Diploma from recognized tertiary institutions; OR
- Mature candidates (aged over 21) with at least 5 years of relevant managerial or supervisory experience. In addition to providing a portfolio on their organisational involvement, leadership and professional experience, relevant candidates are required to sit an admission test and interview.

部分對課程有興趣的童軍領袖認為此課程的設計具有一定吸引力，因為「領袖木章訓練系統」乃此文憑的核心科目，共佔 9 個學分，而木章持有人更可申請學分轉移，使他們在提升童軍領袖技能之餘，亦能獲取具認受性的學術資格，可謂一舉兩得。而部分童軍領袖亦表示期望能成為此文憑的首屆學員，並相信融合了領導才之理論、實踐及現代管理模式的課程內容，可有助他們更有效掌握領導才及管理技巧，以應用於童軍運動及日常工作中。

為期兩年的兼讀制課程將於 2007 年 9 月開課。已獲錄取的首屆學員，並持有有效委任書 1 年或以上之現役童軍領袖可申請「林大輝慈善基金」之學費資助計畫，每名申請獲批之領袖可獲最高港幣 \$10,000 之學費資助，有關基金之申請截止日期為 9 月 30 日，詳情可向策劃署查詢（電話：2957 6377）。
