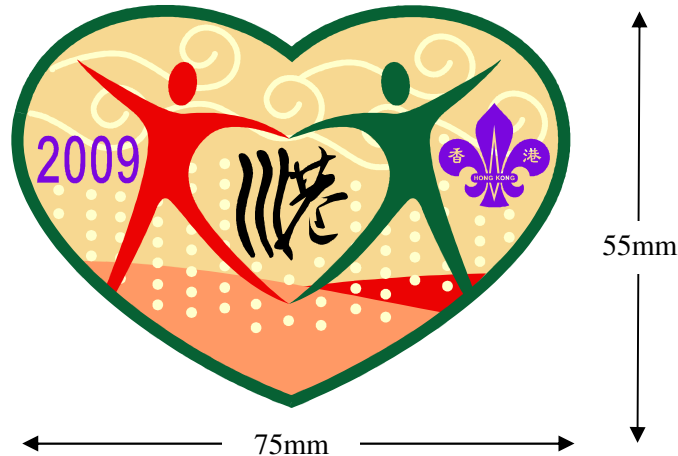


Hong Kong Scout Sichuan Service Scheme Commemorative Badge



To support post-earthquake reconstruction in Sichuan, the Scout Association of Hong Kong plans to be involved in a number of reconstruction, training, service and exchange programs targeting young people in the quake-damaged areas of the province over the next few years. During the current year, Scout units of the Association Headquarters and the five Regions will organize various service projects under the auspices of the “2009 Hong Kong Scout Sichuan Service Scheme.”

The Chief Commissioner has authorized a participants’ commemorative badge for all members who will be organizing and/or serving in any approved project under the Scheme (see the drawing above, **green** border), to be worn for six months starting from the first day of the project. This official participants’ commemorative badge should be worn above the right breast pocket of the uniform, on top of the Scout awards/award ribbons (if any).

There will also be a general commemorative badge (see the drawing above, **red** border) available in the Scout Shop for purchase by others for HK\$10 each. Please note that this badge should not be worn on the uniform. All proceeds from the sale of the badge will be transferred to “Scout Association of Hong Kong - Sichuan Relief Fund”.
