In 1927, the Governor of Hong Kong gave his assent to Ordinance No. 22 of 1927 whereby the Boy Scouts Association Hong Kong Branch was formally incorporated. The original Ordinance was subsequently amended and reamended in 1939, 1950, 1975 and 1997 to become Cap. 268 and finally Cap. 1005 of the Laws of Hong Kong.
