



Continuous Education Policy

This circular promulgates the Association's policy on Continuous Education, and advises all uniformed Leaders (including Commissioners and Leaders) to continue their education and training after completing the Wood Badge training.

As a youth education and development organisation, the Association strives her best to identify and provide suitable training for adult leadership and guidance for young people. "Wood Badge" is an insignia to identify that the holder has completed formal and strict Scout Leader Training, and is a competent Leader. We expect Leaders, after completing the Wood Badge training, to continue their education and training to develop their knowledge and skills with the times, thus enhance the quality of their attitude, knowledge and skills in management and leadership. In addition to enhance their personal growth, Leaders would foster our youths to let them experience the best Scouting life.

Training Branch, Programme Branch, Development and Adult Resources Branch, Leadership Training Institute and Regions provide different types of continuous training to Leaders. Leaders should actively participate in continuous training to cope with the needs of their duties. Leaders may also consider participating in overseas training and continuous training provided by other organisations with a view to broaden their horizons.

The Association will consider the appointments/re-appointments of Leaders with reference to their progress in continuous training.
