



Youth Involvement in Decision-making Policy

This circular sets out the purpose of implementing Youth Involvement in Decision-making and the corresponding arrangement.

To give full effect to Youth Involvement in Decision-making, the Association formulated the policy scope and objectives for Scouting in Hong Kong based on the 《World Scout Youth Involvement Policy》 with a view to, under the guidance of adults, enhance youth involvement in Scouting in different aspects and at different levels, and nurture a sense of responsibility and mission among youth members in a way to pass the torch onto the next generation.

A balanced mechanism will be established so as to encourage youth members to assume an active and positive role at different levels of Scouting while displaying tolerance and respect for collective decisions.

Youth members are also encouraged to take up the role of frontline leaders after completing their respective stages of youth membership and engage themselves in daily operation of groups/units so as to develop and accumulate experience in decision-making.

Programme Branch will continue to work in collaboration with all other Branches, Regions, Districts and related units to promote the above related work so as to fully implement this policy.
