



Awards and Decorations conferred by Government / other National Scout Organisations of World Organisation of Scout Movement / Other Bodies

This circular supersedes the Administration Circular No. 04/2014 issued on 15 April 2014.

In accordance with Rule 6.6.13 of “Policy, Organisation and Rules” of Scout Association of Hong Kong, Scout members may only wear the following awards and decorations on Hong Kong Scout uniform after verification of the documentation of the award and decorations by Administration Branch:

1. Awards and Decorations conferred by the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and by the former sovereignty (Table 1 of “List of Awards and Decorations to be worn on Scout Uniform”)
2. Awards and Decorations conferred by other National Scout Organisations of the World Organisation of Scout Movement (Table 2 of “List of Awards and Decorations to be worn on Scout Uniform”)
3. Other Awards and Decorations approved by the Chief Commissioner (Table 3 of “List of Awards and Decorations to be worn on Scout Uniform”)

If Scout members wish to wear on their uniform those awards and decorations not listed in “List of Awards and Decorations to be worn on Scout Uniform”, they are required to obtain approval of the Chief Commissioner, by submitting written application with full documentation of the awards and decorations (including copies of gazette announcement, notification letter, award certificate, award criteria and descriptions) via Administration Branch. Administration Branch will as necessary update the List which can be obtained by scanning the QR Code below.

Scout members shall not wear the above mentioned awards and decorations on uniform before permission given to him/her.

Lay Members when attending events in Scout capacity in blazers shall also comply with the above requirements for wearing awards and decorations when attending events.
