



Cathay Aviation Certificate Programme Introductory Briefing Session Cum Flight Simulator Experience Activity

Launched in 2005, “Cathay Aviation Certificate Programme” (CACP) organized by the Cathay Dragon and Cathay Pacific is a programme designed to educate, motivate and inspire young people who are interested in pursuing an aviation-related career by offering them a comprehensive aviation training programme and a range of aviation activities. One of the CACP highlights is that participants will be guided throughout by pilots of Cathay Dragon and Cathay Pacific, who will act as mentors and offer career and personal development advice. Scout Association of Hong Kong has been invited by Cathay Dragon and Cathay Pacific to become one of the co-organisers of the CACP in 2016. Since then, a total of 34 scout members have participated in the CACP.

The CACP is well-recognized among the local aviation entities. Participants successfully completed the CACP will stand a very good chance of entering the industry. Almost half of the CACP’s graduates to date have already embarked a career in the aviation industry, including working as flight dispatchers, air traffic controllers, aircraft engineers, cabin crew and pilots.

Applications for the 2020 CACP will be opened between November and December 2019. Qualified scout applicants will be recommended to attend an interview in January 2020. Successful ones will then take part in a nine-month intensive aviation-related training programme, facility visits and will board a scheduled Cathay Dragon and Cathay Pacific service for an observation flight.

Because the toughness of the interview process of the CACP, Leadership Training Institute will conduct 2 introductory briefing sessions to better prepare scout members who intend to apply for the 2020 CACP. Following the CACP Introductory Briefing Session, there will be a Flight Simulator Experience Activity in Aviation Training Centre.

Scout members possessing the recognized scout membership are welcome to join one of the briefing sessions and flight simulator experience activity.

Internal interview for scout members will be held in December 2019. Scout members who have passed the internal interview will be nominated by the Scout Association of Hong Kong to join the CACP formal interview in January 2020.

Eligibility of the CACP:

1. Hold a Hong Kong Permanent Identity Card; and
2. Excellent command of English, both oral and written; and
3. Aged 18 to 25 (as of December 2019); and
4. Obtained at least Five Level 2s in the HKDSE, or other equivalent or higher qualifications; and
5. Able to attend the nine-month programme with 100% attendance

Scout Membership required for Scout Selection Programme:

1. Venture Scouts or Rovers Scout with valid membership record books for not less than one year;
or
2. Scout Leaders with valid Leader Warrants or Instructor Appointments for not less than one year.

Fee: Free of charge


Briefing session application deadline:
