



Arrangement on Scout Activities under the Novel Coronavirus Infection (5)

This circular substitutes Activity Guideline No. 06/2020 issued on 3 March 2020.

Pursuant to the Government's latest announcement in response to COVID-19 that all schools (including kindergartens, primary schools, secondary schools and special schools) will continue to be suspended until further notice, the Association has decided to correspondingly continue to suspend ALL local scout activities including Scout Group meetings, activities and training, etc. **until further notice** (except for "Hong Kong Scout – Health Guard" programme). This circular is applicable to all scout activities organized by Groups, Districts, Regions and Association Headquarters.

For essential adult members' meetings, please as far as possible avoid face-to-face meeting and convene it through video conference, tele-conference, etc., in order to reduce social contact and minimise the risk of being infected.
