Designated Outside Bodies includes the below 5 categories; <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.1) any school as defined in s.3(1) of the Education Ordinance (Cap. 279); any regulations made thereunder and any amending legislation; 1.2) any non-governmental organization that is receiving recurrent subvention from the Social Welfare Department; 1.3) any “national sports association” which is affiliated to its respective International Federation and is a member of the Sports Federation & Olympic Committee of Hong Kong, China; 1.4) any uniformed group (11 units) and youth organization (2 units) that is receiving recurrent subvention from the Home Affairs Bureau; and 1.5) any Government department. 2. Non-peak date includes Saturday, Sunday, public holiday and the summer vacation (from 1/7 to 31/8). 3. Schools can get the Scout unit’s camp fee offer when applying day camp or evening camp at non-peak date. 4. Schools can get special activity offer when applying day camp at the non-peak date. 5. 13 youth uniform organizations in Hong Kong (including Flag-guads, Adventure Corps, Air Cadet Corps, Girl Guides, Red Cross, Sea Cadet Corps, St. John Ambulance, Boys’ Brigade, Girl’s Brigade, Road Safety Patrol, JPC, CAS and AMS) can get Scout unit camp fee offer. 6.
