



Hong Kong Scout Rally 2022 Admission Arrangement

Hong Kong Scout Rally 2022 will be held at 10:00 am on 27 November 2022 (Sunday) in Hong Kong Stadium. Details are as follows:

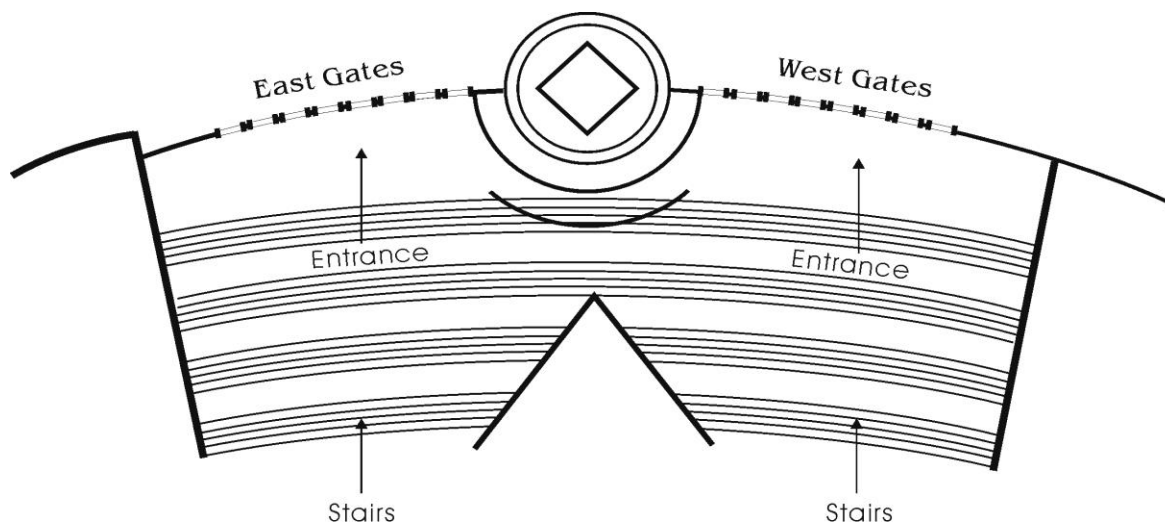
Admission Time

The Stadium will be opened for entry at 8:30 am. Participants should be seated before 9:45am. Please allow sufficient time to complete all epidemic preventive measures before entry.

Admission Tickets

1. Scout Groups: Participating Scout Groups shall present the Admission Tickets for entering Hong Kong Stadium, and be seated at the assigned section of the Stadium as indicated on the Admission Tickets. Youth members and their relatives from the same Group should be accompanied by their responsible leaders for entry.
2. Scout Groups' Lay Members and Sponsors: They will be admitted to the Scout Rally upon presentation of Admission Tickets. Collection arrangement of their Admission Tickets reserved by Scout Groups will be announced in due course.
3. Guests and Adult Members: Participants and their relatives shall present Admission Tickets for entering Hong Kong Stadium, and be seated at the assigned section of the Stadium as indicated on the Admission Tickets.
4. Youth Award Recipients: Youth Award Recipients shall present the letters of notification issued by Programme Branch, where as their relatives (max. 2 persons) shall present Admission Tickets for entering Hong Kong Stadium.

Dress Code

1. Youth members : Scout Uniform.
2. Leaders : Scout Uniform No.3 [Beret, Shirt, Scarf, Trousers/Skirt] or Scout Uniform No.1 [Beret, Shirt, Tunic, Trousers/Skirt, Tie] with Medal(s).
3. Lay Members : Lounge Suit or Scout Uniform No.3 [Beret, Shirt, Scarf, Trousers/Skirt] or Scout Uniform No.1 [Beret, Shirt, Tunic, Trousers/Skirt, Tie] with Medal(s).
4. Guests : Lounge Suit or Uniform with Medal(s).
5. Parents and friends : Smart Casual.

Scout Rally Souvenir Badge

1. **Wearing Period:** From 27 November 2022 to 26 May 2023
2. **Wearing Method:** The badge should be worn above the right pocket or immediately above the award emblems of the Scout uniform. Scout members may choose to wear only the badge with blue background or the badge with purple background (See illustration on the right).



Epidemic Preventive Measures:

1. Participants shall check the body temperature and obtain a negative result of the COVID-19 rapid antigen test (RAT) before leaving home. Those with fever or any respiratory symptoms, or tested positive, should not attend the event. Participants shall complete the Health Declaration Form before entering the venue.
2. According to the latest precautionary measure of the Government and the Hong Kong Stadium, all persons, except those exempted, are required to use the “LeaveHomeSafe” mobile application (the App) to scan the venue QR code. Persons who are aged below 12 or aged 65 or above, and those with disabilities that render use of the App difficult will be exempted from the requirement of using the App. All exempted persons are required to complete a personal information registration form. If a person aged below 12 is accompanied by an adult who has complied with the applicable “LeaveHomeSafe” requirement, then the person aged below 12 is not required to complete the registration form.
3. Those aged 5 or above shall show their vaccination records / medical exemption certificates for inspection upon entry (Persons with “Red Code” or “Amber Code” cannot enter the venue).
4. Participants must wear masks all the time at the venue.

Transportation

1. Road Arrangement

- (1) From 6:30 am to the conclusion of the Scout Rally, a one-way bilinear traffic flow on Eastern Hospital Road and Caroline Hill Road will be adopted. All vehicles at Leighton Road will be diverted to Hysan Avenue and Hoi Ping Road, then Caroline Hill Road to Hong Kong Stadium.
- (2) Right after the conclusion of the Scout Rally [around 12:30 pm], part of Caroline Hill Road will be closed as needed. Drivers must follow instructions of the Police.

2. Coach

- (3) Deadline for applying Coach Permits has expired. Groups/Units which have not applied for Coach Permits shall NOT arrange coaches for transporting their members to and from the Stadium.
- (4) Coach Permits will be issued to Groups/Units together with the Admission Tickets. Details of the time and location for alighting and picking-up passengers will be marked on the Permits.

3. Taxi and Private Cars

- (1) Taxis and private cars will be allowed to drop off and pick up passengers at the front gateway of Hong Kong Stadium. However, no waiting will be permitted.

4. Car Park

- (1) Car Park of Hong Kong Stadium will not be open to the public and only vehicles with Rally Parking Permits will be allowed to use the Car Park. The Permits must be displayed prominently on the windscreen of the vehicles.
- (2) Limited parking spaces of charge are available at the carpark of South China Athletic Association, near Hong Kong Stadium.

Points to Note:

1. If Red / Black Rainstorm Signal OR Typhoon No. 8 or higher Signal is still hoisted by 6:00 a.m. of 27 November 2022, Scout Rally will be cancelled without further notice. If Scout Rally has to be cancelled because of special circumstances, announcement will be made on the Association's website and Facebook Page before 6:00 a.m. on 27 November 2022.
2. For safety reasons and to be considerate towards others, please avoid gathering on the road outside Hong Kong Stadium and at its staircases.
3. When the ceremonies are in progress, all participants should remain in seats and comply with the house rules.
4. During the National Flag Raising Ceremony, all participants should remain standing solemnly and silent, facing the Flag, and all Leaders and Commissioners should make the Scout salute.
5. In case of emergency, participants may be ordered to evacuate from the venue through the public address system in the Stadium. Participants shall remain calm, escort those who require assistance, follow instructions of Stadium staff and evacuate from the venue via the closest safe exit immediately. Group leaders shall report the latest status by email to rally@scout.org.hk. If serious or critical situation occurs during evacuation, please contact Rally working staff or inform the Rally Organizer at 9537 7635 immediately.
