



29th Cub Scout Basic Course (I)

The captioned course aims at helping Cub Scout Section leaders learn and apply the fundamental principles of Scouting when leading or assisting in cub scout pack meetings. Through this course Cub Scout Section leaders will experience various pack meetings which are useful to their daily pack operations. Mr FOK Chun-sing Dennis, Assistant Leader Trainer, will be the Course Leader.

3. Eligibility: Leaders who:

1. hold a valid Warrant of Cub Scout Section / Warrant or Appointment of Non-Sectional / Salaried Staff; and
2. have completed the General Information Course.

4. Course Fee: Leaders who hold a Warrant of Cub Scout Section / Appointment of Non-Sectional / Salaried Staff (Recipients of Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training): \$230

Course fee covers the costs of course materials, activities, meals (except lunch on 4 June 2023), refreshment and accommodation.

5. During the course, participants should be dressed in Scout uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.
6. This training course is subsidized by the “Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training”. Participants with a valid warrant/valid appointment for instructor shall pay half of the course fee.
