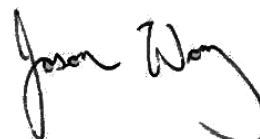




11th National Scout Jamboree, SRI LANKA

Date	17 – 23 January 2027 (All Contingent Members, Leaders and International Service Team are expected to arrive the campsite on 17 January 2027 and leave on 23 January 2027)
Venue	Mahinda Rajapaksa Sports Complex, Diyagama, Colombo, SRI LANKA
Eligibility	Contingent Members : Scout Members aged from 12 to 18 with no less than 1 year experience after investiture (Born between 18 January 2008 and 17 January 2015) Leaders of Contingent : Scout Leaders aged 18 or above with no less than 2 years' experience after investiture (Born on or before 17 January 2009) International Service Team (IST) : Scout Members or Leaders aged 18 or above with prior overseas travel experience and no less than 2 years' experience after investiture (Born on or before 17 January 2009)
Camp Fee	Leaders of Contingent & Contingent Members : USD 200 International Service Team (IST) : USD 150 <i>(The fee includes inland transportation between Bandaranayake International Airport (CMB) and the site, meals from dinner on 17 January to breakfast on 23 January 2027, tents for accommodation, Official Jamboree Kit, 24/7 access to onsite Health Center facilities, security, and emergency care etc.)</i>
Air Ticket*	Around HKD 5,000 (round trip economy class excluding airport tax & relevant surcharges) <i>* The air ticket cost is for reference only. Purchase will be arranged based on the decision of the Contingent Leader (EITHER (i) group purchase, with the actual airfare to be confirmed at a later date, OR (ii) by the Contingent Members themselves at the Contingent Leader's direction). All Contingent Members should depart and return according to the Contingent Leader's arrangement.</i> <i>* ISTs are to arrange their own air tickets and transportation to and from the campsite in accordance with the instructions by the Jamboree organization team.</i>
Remarks	➤ Applicants may be required to attend an interview for selection. Please note that all decisions regarding shortlisting and interview results are final, and no appeals will be entertained. ➤ Applicants, as well as the parents or guardians of applicants under the age of 18, are required to attend the briefing session as and when directed by the Contingent Leader and/or the International Branch. ➤ Applicants are required to possess a valid "Certificate of Swimming Test" when participating in any kind of water activities overseas. ➤ Priority will be given to leader applicants who wish to join the Contingent Management Team (CMT) of the Hong Kong Contingent. Please indicate areas of assistance you could offer to CMT in Part E (Skills & Interest) on P.2 of Form (IL/1). ➤ Participants are responsible for their personal gear, passage, medical and travel insurance, airport departure taxes, visa application (if applicable), bank charges, remittance difference, any additional charges for offsite activities, quarantine fee (if applicable), cost incurred by the host, personal and contingent's expenses as well as expenses arising from emergencies. ➤ Participants are advised to arrange their own travel insurance.

	➤ Participants are responsible for ensuring that all their travel documents are valid and eligible for travelling as on the date of departure and for at least 6 months thereafter, and that the appropriate visa(s) are included, if required. Fees paid will not be refunded due to any issues arising from travel documents, visas and/or personal reasons. ➤ If the participant withdraws after registration, the fees paid will not be refunded. ➤ Participants must attend all activities throughout the entire duration of the Jamboree. Unauthorized departure, lateness, early dismissal, or leaving the group midway is strictly prohibited. ➤ Photographs and video recordings will be taken during the Jamboree. These media may be used by the Association and the host for publicity, promotional materials, and official reports. ➤ The International Branch, Scout Association of Hong Kong reserves the right of final interpretation and decision on all matters regarding this Jamboree and its regulations. ➤ By submitting the application, applicants and their parents/guardians indicate that they have read and agreed to all the contents of this circular. ➤ For more Jamboree information, please visit: www.jamboree.scout.hk.

Applications of Youth Members and Leaders in Scout Groups must be endorsed by their respective Group Scout Leaders and District Commissioners. Applications of other Leaders must be endorsed by their respective Commissioners.
