3. Eligibility:
- Leaders who hold a valid Warrant / Certificate of Appointment for Instructor, or Certificate of Appointment for Lay Member / Salaried Staff; or
 - Venture Scouts who proceed to the assessment for Dragon Scout Award; or
 - Rover Scouts who hold a valid Record Book; or
 - Hong Kong Identity Card holders who aged 18 or above.

4. Course Fee:
- Leaders who hold a valid Warrant or Certificate of Appointment for Instructor, or Salaried Staff, or Venture Scouts who proceed to the assessment for Dragon Scout Award or Rover Scouts who hold a valid Record Book : (Recipients of Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training) : \$15 per person
 - Lay members who hold a valid Appointment or Hong Kong Identity Card holders who aged 18 or above : (Non-recipients of Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training) : \$30 per person.
- Course fee covers cost of course materials.

Eligibility Criteria: Scout members of Venture Scout section/ Rover Scout section with valid membership record books and; from needy family including currently in receipt of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA), or full/half grant under the Student Financial Assistance Scheme (SFAS), or 50% or above level of assistance from The Tertiary Student Finance Scheme (TSFS)/ Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Full-time Tertiary Students (NLSFT); or under other special financial difficulties.
