



Prevention of Pneumonia and Respiratory Tract Infection (II)

The Association has issued the Activity Guideline No. 01/2020 on 8 January 2020 to remind members to maintain good personal hygiene and take the preventive measures when travelling outside Hong Kong. In the course of Scout activities (including Scout Group meetings, activities and training, etc), leaders should observe the followings:

- Remind members to have temperature check before Scout activities. If a member is found to have symptoms of respiratory infection or fever, he/she should not attend the activity and seek medical advice immediately.
- Remind members to perform hand hygiene frequently, especially before touching the mouth, nose or eyes.
- Provide sufficient face masks and hand hygiene facilities (e.g. soap and alcohol handrub) for members to use when necessary.
