



## **Go Hiking x Clean Trails**

This circular substitutes Programme Circular No. 70/2020 issued on 15 October 2020.

Scout Movement emphasizes on the development of interactions with nature. By outdoor activities in natural environment, members would equip with different wilderness living skills and strengthen mental and physical health, leading to the moral, intellectual, physical, social and aesthetic development. “Go Hiking” Campaign has been launched since 2014 for encouraging our members to enjoy the nature. Till now, over 9,000 scouts have participated hiking trips under the Campaign.

To echo the WOSM Earth Tribe initiative, we incorporate the reduce and reuse concepts into the scheme, encourage participants to use reusable container/bags and bottle for food and water, also clean up the trails when hike. Join together to create a better world.

All participants could obtain a hiking stick medallion which is specifically designed for each route, after the trip completion following with simple reporting steps (Please refer the details in the following section). Also if you have practiced designated requirements in “Clean Trails”, you will be awarded a special design “Clean Trails” badge.
