



Hong Kong Scout 110th Anniversary
Hong Kong Scout International Regatta
(Competition Events)



In celebrating the 110th Anniversary of Scouting in Hong Kong, the Association will roll out a series of signature events, including the Hong Kong Scout International Regatta to be held in May 2022, to promote the diversified sea activities of Scouting in Hong Kong. The competition events include Kayak, Dragon Boat, Sailing, Standard Boat and SUP. Scouts, Venture Scouts, Rover Scouts, Leaders and Lay Members are welcome to join. Details are as follows:

		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. This Race is open for <b><u>Scouts/ Venture Scouts/ Rover Scouts.</u></b></li> <li>2. There are 7 members per team. The Coxswain must be the holder of the Level 3 Scout Standard Boat Certificate.</li> <li>3. The team with the best time will be the champion, the second best time will be 1st runner-up and so on.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. This Race is open for <b><u>Scouts/ Venture Scouts/ Rover Scouts.</u></b></li> <li>2. There are 8 members per team. The Coxswain must be the holder of the Level 3 Scout Standard Boat Certificate.</li> <li>3. Event		<b>D. Dragon Boat (100m)</b>	
Format		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. This Race (9-metre-12-seats Small Dragon Boat) is open for <b><u>Scouts/ Venture Scouts/ Rover Scouts/ Leaders/ Lay Members/ Other Uniform Groups.</u></b></li> <li>2. Each team shall not have more than 16 people to sign up, including 11 starters, i.e. 1 drummer and 10 paddlers and 5 reserves. There shall not be less than 9 people on each boat in the event, i.e. 1 drummer and at least 8 paddlers on each dragon boat.</li> <li>3. The team with the best time will be the champion, the second best time will be 1st runner-up and so on.</li> </ol>	
		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Obtained a valid Certificate of Swimming Test; and</li> <li>2. Each event will be divided by age groups, Youth members (Scouts, Venture Scouts, Rover Scouts), Open (Leaders and Lay Members); and</li> <li>3. Each team must have a steersman aged 18 or above, the organizer can provide a steersman if needed. Steersman must be the holder of the Coach Certificate issued by Hong Kong China Dragon Boat Association/Traditional Boat Coach Certificate issued by Hong Kong Canoe Union/Assistant Dragon Boat Instructor or above of the Scout Association of Hong Kong.</li> </ol> (The above requirements are not applicable for International Scouts and Uniform Groups.)

Event		<b>E. Sailing (Double)</b>
Format		This Race is open for <b><u>Scouts/ Venture Scouts/ Rover Scouts/ Leaders/ Lay Members</u></b> . The participant with the best time will be the champion, the second best time will be 1st runner-up and so on.
Eligibility		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Obtained a valid Certificate of Swimming Test; and</li> <li>2. Each event will be divided by age groups, Scouts and Open (Venture Scouts, Rover Scouts, Leaders and Lay Members); and</li> <li>3. Participants must be holder of Level 2 Dinghy (“Sailing”) Certificate or above issued by the Hong Kong Sailing Federation.</li> </ol>

**Application:** Please submit your application with the following items to Hong Kong Island Region, 19/F, Hong Kong Scout Centennial Building, 23 Yat Sin Street, Wan Chai, Hong Kong on or before the application deadline.

1. Applicant should fill out the Application Form, with approval from the Group Scout Leader or respective Sectional Leader (Except Leaders). Applicant who is under 18 years old, need to submit the completed Parent’s Consent Form ;
2. For the application fee, a crossed cheque (one cheque per unit) payable to the “**Scout Association of Hong Kong**” shall be submitted;
3. All youth members must submit the copy of their valid Record Book (P.1-3 Personal and Group Information Page). Leaders must submit the copy of their valid Warrant/ Certificate of Appointment for Instructor/Certificate of Appointment for Lay Member;
4. Copy of the Certificate of Swimming Test;
5. Copies of related certificates;
6. As required by the HKSAR Government’s latest health and safety regulations, and to protect the public health, all participants must complete two doses of vaccination recognized by the HKSAR Government 14 days before the Competition Day. (i.e. 7 May 2022 or before). Please refer to the [List of COVID-19 Vaccines Recognized for Specified Purposes](#) for details.

**Anti-epidemic Measures:** All participants must fulfil the following conditions before admission:

1. Complete the electronic health declaration form, declare the personal health situation and travel record;
2. Use the “LeaveHomeSafe App” and scan the specific QR code displayed at the venue;
3. Pass the temperature screening station at the entrance of the venue, to ensure body temperature is normal;
4. Present proof of two doses of COVID-19 vaccination record;
5. Present negative result proof of a PCR-based nucleic acid test for COVID-19 collected within 48 hours prior to the competition;
6. Wear a mask at all time;
7. **The above 1 to 6 measures are subject to update, in accordance with the latest Government Guideline.**

**Deadline:** 28 March 2022 (Monday)

**Awards:** Trophies include Champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up for each event (No. of awards depend on the number of participants)

Dress Code: Casual, attires suitable for water activities (Sun-protection clothing, rubber soled shoes covering heel and toes and cap), and bring along their Scout Uniforms.

- Remarks:
1. Late applications or applications without providing copies of related certificates or a valid cheque for application fee will not be accepted;
  2. Applicants will be notified through **e-mails** for the application results;
  3. Participants must bring along their Certificates of Swimming Test during the Competition Days;
  4. An official ballot will be taken place in the Briefing Session to determine the ordering and boats used for the Competition;
  5. The activity will be cancelled if Amber Rainstorm Signal, Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 or above is issued and still in force 3 hours before the activity is scheduled to begin or other circumstances causing the activity not able to be continued;
  6. Participants who are aged under 18 must have consent by their parents or guardians. Participants are required to download and fill in the Parent's Consent Form;
  7. The length of the course will be adjusted according to the actual environment. No replacement is allowed during the competition;
  8. The result will be announced on the Event Day;
  9. Each participant will receive one set of souvenir, no matter how many events he/she signs up;
  10. The Organizer has been reviewing the feasibility of relevant measures and will make adjustments on a timely basis in view of the latest development of the disease. Please refer to the HKSAR Government's Press Release for the according to the latest disease prevention measures;
  11. Should there be any changes regarding the rules, the Organizer will make announcements at the Briefing Session;
  12. If there are any inadequacies and amendments for the terms and conditions of the competition, the organizer reserves the right to make the amendment without prior notice;
  13. The competition is subject to the approval on the government departments;
