



## **The 63<sup>rd</sup> Jamboree-On-The-Air (JOTA) cum The 24<sup>th</sup> Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTI)**



The Jamboree-On-The-Air cum Jamboree-On-The-Internet (JOTA-JOTI) is an annual international event for World Scouting organized by the World Organization of the Scout Movement. It usually takes place on the 3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of October every year and millions of Scouts and Guides worldwide will make contact with one another over such weekend. Scouts around the world are encouraged to engage in conversations through radio and telecommunications for exploring similarities and differences between each other in culture and Scouting.

This year, youth members and leaders who have registered online and have completed online activities are eligible to a specially designed badge and a certificate of participation. Supply of badges is limited and available only while stocks last.
