- Eligibility :
- For Scout Units :
    - Cub Scouts, Scouts, Venture Scouts or Rover Scouts with valid membership record book ; or
    - Scout Leaders with valid Leader Warrant or Instructor Appointment; or
    - Lay Members with valid Lay Member Appointment ◦
  - Schools, Uniformed Groups and Service units of Welfare NGOs :
    - Schools :

Applicants should be from a registered primary / secondary school or tertiary education institute offering formal curriculum. All participants should be at Primary 3 and above or equivalent.
    - Uniformed Groups :

Applying party should be from a registered uniformed group which received recurrent subvention by Home Affairs Bureau. Participants must be valid youth members or leaders of that uniformed group.
    - Service units of welfare NGOs:

Applying party must be from the organization which exempt from tax under section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance with youth as its major clientele; and the participants are aged between 8 - 25 (as at the event day).
  - Participants who are aged under 18 must be led by one leader (for Scout Units) or teacher / instructor (for Schools, Uniformed Groups and Service units of Welfare NGOs) during the activity, and must have consent by their parents or guardians. Participants are required to download and fill in the Parent's Consent Form (PT/46) ([http://www.scout.org.hk/article\\_attach/10502/PT46.pdf](http://www.scout.org.hk/article_attach/10502/PT46.pdf)). The leader / teacher / instructor of the participating parties are requested to collect all the forms on or before the event date, and should bring all the forms during the activity.

No. of Places : 1. Every session should comprise minimum 10 participants and maximum 20 participants.  
2. Each Scout unit can register 3 sessions maximum.  
3. Each School / Uniformed Group / Service unit of Welfare NGO can register 2 session maximum.

Activity : 1. The activity will be mainly conducted in Cantonese and supplemented with elementary aviation terms in English.  
2. To meet different level of participants' learning needs, content and activities are divided to 3 levels:  
i) Cub Scouts / Students of Primary 3 to Primary 6 :  
• making of hand glider, elementary flight simulator experience, visit the advanced aviation training centre  
ii) Scouts / Students of Secondary 1 to 3 :  
• elementary flight simulator training, advanced flight simulator experience  
iii) Venture Scout or above / Students of Secondary 4 or above :  
• advanced flight simulator training

Fee : Free of charge

Application method : 1. Interested parties should check if the timeslot is available by clicking the link [atc.scoutlti.org](http://atc.scoutlti.org) (QR code refer to the right) and fill in the online form before deadline.  
2. Application should be submitted at least 2 weeks before the event day.  
3. Aviation Training Centre focus on providing services to Scout Members, priority will be given to Scout Members' applications for this activity.  
4. Other applications will be handled by first-come-first-serve basis. Aviation Training Centre reserves the right to cancel or reject any applications due to the operations of the centre or other reasons.



Dress code : 1. Scout units  
i) Youth members : Scout Uniform of its own section  
ii) Scout leaders : Uniform No3 (Standard Uniform)  
iii) Lay member : Uniform No3 (Standard Uniform) / Casual wear (avoid wearing sandals or flip-flops)  
2. Uniformed group members : Uniform of its Uniformed group  
3. School and Service units of welfare NGOs : School Uniform / Casual wear (avoid wearing sandals or flip-flops)

Remarks : 1. The application result will be informed by email.  
2. The participant(s) who is absent without providing valid reason may lead to be suspended from application of activities for 1 year so as to make allowance for other applicants.  
3. When Typhoon Signal No.8 or Black Rainstorm Warning is issued 3 hours prior the activity, it will be cancelled and postponed.
