### 89<sup>th</sup> Sing Song Course and 70<sup>th</sup> Campfire Leader Course

The captioned courses will be held by Training Branch in November to December 2020 and Mr WAT Wai-ching Stephen, Trainer will be the Course Leader. After completing the courses, candidates should be able to:

1. state purpose and significance of Singing in Scouting activities;
2. sing at least 30 traditional Scouting songs, and recognize different types of songs;
3. read numbered musical notation, grasp rhythm and tempo;
4. state significance and categories of campfire;
5. state ceremony, order and division of labor in campfire; and
6. state of the principles of selection and decoration of campfire site.

Details of the Courses are as follows:

2. Medium of instruction: English

3. Eligibility: Leaders who:

1. hold a valid Warrant, Certificate of Appointment for Instructor, or Certificate of Appointment for Lay Member or Salaried Staff; and
2. have completed the General Information Course.

4. Course Fee: 1. Leaders who hold a valid Warrant or Instructor who hold a valid Appointment, Salaried Staff: (Recipients of Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training): \$312  
2. Lay Members who hold a valid Appointment: (Non-recipients of Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training): \$624  
Course fee covers cost of courses materials, meals and refreshment.

5. Application: 1. Please fill out the Application Form PT/02e, and send it by mail or by hand together with a crossed cheque payable to the “Scout Association of Hong Kong” to Training Branch, Room 908, 9/F, Hong Kong Scout Centre, Scout Path, Austin Road, Kowloon on or before deadline. The Application Form can be downloaded at <http://www.scout.org.hk/en/download/training/>.  
2. Enrolment and payment of participation fee can be done through “Training Management System” (<https://tms.scout.org.hk/member/home>) ( e-Enrolment & Payment Services) on the internet.  
3. Incomplete form or copies of the prescribed certificates may affect the application result.

6. Deadline: **16 October 2020 (Friday)** (Late applicant will not be entertained)

7. Others: 1. Applicants will be informed in e-mail of the application result.  
2. No refund will be made once admitted to the course.  
3. Fee paid and place enrolled are not transferable.  
4. Participants should complete 89<sup>th</sup> Sing Song Course and 70<sup>th</sup> Campfire Leader Course, and attend all sessions of the courses on time. Certificates will only be issued to participants who completed the above courses.  
5. During the courses, participants should be dressed in Scout uniform or other attire assigned by the Course Leader.  
6. If applicants did not receive notification of acceptance/rejection, two weeks prior to the commencement of the course, or for enquiries, please contact Miss Tiffany CHAN, Training Officer at 2957 6473 during office hours.

Remarks:

1. This training course is subsidized by the “Subsidy Scheme for Scout Training”. Participants with a valid warrant/a valid appointment for instructor only need to pay 50% of the fee.
2. Needy Youth Members who want to participate in the training course can apply the “Assistance Scheme for Needy Student Members’ Training” for full fee remission. Eligibility Criteria: Scout members of Rover Scout section with valid membership record books and; from needy family including currently in receipt of Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA), or full/half grant under the Student Financial Assistance Scheme (SFAS), or 50% or above level of assistance from The Tertiary Student Finance Scheme (TSFS)/ Non-means-tested Loan Scheme for Full-time Tertiary Students (NLSFT); or under other special financial difficulties.
